Issuance and Usage Guide



Verify Personal Graduation Data

Timing: Before midterm of graduation semester

Items: Name, Date of Birth, ID No., Dept./Grad. Program, Email, etc. (If errors found, contact the Registration Division of the Academic Affairs Office.)

Path: Taipei Tech Portal / System of Academic Affairs / Studnet Query / Student Status Information



Collect Paper Degree Certificate

Collect the paper degree certificate at the time and location announced by the Office of Academic Affairs.



Academic Office Issues Digital Certificate

Sent to your personal email inbox within **15 business days**

If not received, contact the Registration Division within **2 months** of receiving the paper certificate.



Save Digital Certificate



Download the digital certificate using the "Download Attachment" method.



Do NOT use "Save As" after opening the file, or "Print to PDF" — this will alter the binary code and cause verification failure.



Digital Certificate Verification Process



Provide Digital Certificate to External Organization

Graduates/Alumni email the digital certificate to external organizations (companies, schools, etc.)



External Organization Uploads & Verifies

Upload certificate to the MOE Electronic Certificate Verification System. Results: Verified, Warning, or Failed.

MOE Electronic Certificate Verification System



Verified Successfully

Certificate authenticated by MOE and the university — valid and up-to-date.



Verification Failed

Certificate not authenticated. File may have been altered. Re-download the original attachment.



Verification Warning

Q1: What is the digital degree certificate used for?

A1: The digital degree certificate is an official legal electronic document with equivalent legal effect as the paper degree certificate. It is complementary to the paper certificate and provides students with more convenient use. Each digital certificate is assigned a digital fingerprint that can be quickly verified through the MOE verification website. The current pilot phase only issues Chinese digital degree certificates.

Q2: Who can apply for a digital degree certificate?

A2: During the first phase (pilot), only 2026 Spring Graduates are eligible to receive the Chinese digital degree certificate.

Q3: What are the fees for the digital degree certificate?

A3: In coordination with the MOE Digital Certificate Promotion Program, the initial issuance of the Chinese digital degree certificate is free of charge. Future applications for English digital degree certificates or reissuance of the Chinese digital degree certificate will be subject to additional fees.

Q4: Can I apply for an English digital certificate?

A4: In the first phase (pilot), only the Chinese digital degree certificate is being issued. The English digital degree certificate will be planned after the system operates stably.
