1. Starting from 2019 academic year, all students enrolled in either the Master's Program, the In-Service Master's Program, or the Doctoral Program must register for a compulsory online course available on the Center for Taiwan Academic Research Ethics Education Website. Students will receive a passing mark on the final examination, and obtain a Certificate of Completion by the end of their first year of the enrollment. To sign up for this online course, please use the following website: <https://ethics.moe.edu.tw/>

Each student taking this course must obtain at the very least a passing grade for the course test as well as the Certificate of Completion. Please note that, students that have not completed this course are not allowed to apply for their degree examination. New students that enrolled during the fall semester or spring semester should log in to the system to sign up for the course beginning either October or March of their respective enrollment years.
